Professor Luis Filgueira did his medical degree at the University of Basel, Switzerland, where he graduated with a doctorate in medicine in 1987. Subsequently, he underwent clinical training between 1988 and 1994 in surgery, gynecology, obstetrics and emergency medicine at various hospitals in Switzerland, including the University Hospital of Basel and Children's Hospital of Zurich, before focusing on an academic teaching and research career in Anatomy and Immunology. He graduated with his professorial habilitation in Anatomy and Immunology from the University of Zurich in 2001, where he spent the years from 1994 to 2001 as a senior teaching and research fellow. He was on a teaching and research tenure track professorial position at the University of Western Australia from 2001 to 2012, before he was appointed as Chair of Anatomy at the University of Fribourg, Switzerland. His teaching competence lies in human gross anatomy (regional, as well as all systems), histology, embryology and immunology, which he teaches to Bachelor and Master students in Medicine and in the Biomedical Sciences. He also contributes to courses in further education in clinical anatomy of various medical disciplines. His research articles cover topics in clinical anatomy, cell biology and immunology and have been published in various prestigious journals, including Nature, Nature Medicine, Journal of Immunology, Journal of Bone and Joint Surgery and Clinical Anatomy.
