Having gained his medical degree from the University of Turin, Italy, in 1991, and specialization in Orthopaedics and Traumatology in 1996, Dr. Zerbinati worked in the orthopaedic field, and for the last 15 years has gained experience in neuro-orthopaedics including time spent in Philadelphia in the service of Neuro-orthopaedics surgery directed by Professor Mary Ann Keenan.
